REGISTRATION:

Please put these dates and times for testing on your calendar. Then fill out and mail your registration to JCHE, PO Box 562, Eagle Point, OR 97524. Call Lorraine Kimmel at 541-826-3427 or 541-890-0391 if you have any questions about registration. **During** testing call 541-890-0391. Checks should be made out to **JCHE**. You do not need to send money now, but please get registered, so we can reserve a test for your child. **Some grades have a limited number of tests.** Especially fourth grade, for which we have only twenty-five test booklets. For questions about the test, call Nancy Olson at 541-601-2257 (days) and 541-878-4238 (evenings only).

If you **pay** in advance (by April 30), your line will **probably** move faster on testing morning. Just for your information, I do not deposit any checks until the last morning of testing. It makes cancellations much easier. On **Monday** morning, please plan to arrive 30 minutes prior to the start time for your test, in order to check in, get name tags, etc. If you are volunteering, allow a few extra minutes. On Tuesday, you may come 10-15 minutes before start time.

If you have a kindergartner through fourth grader, please accompany them to their room and help them fill out the cover of their test booklet or answer sheet.

SUPPLIES TO BRING OR NOT BRING TO TESTING

Please bring scratch paper, a healthy snack & drink, several sharpened #2 pencils, a book to read, and a self-addressed, stamped business (long white #10) size envelope for every **two** children in the family. If you prefer, you are welcome to send the envelope in with your pre-registration. **DO NOT BRING MACHINES WITH EARPHONES OR CALCULATORS** to testing.

TEST RESULTS

We will mail your test results to **YOU** in the self-addressed, stamped envelope that you give us. **YOU KEEP THE RESULTS.** The copy you get is the only copy, so guard it well.☺ The ESD does NOT want the results. In fact, they may get irritated if you try to turn them in. They **may** request them from you in the future, however. If you decide to enroll your child in school or they are participating in sports, the school, or coach & or athletic director will want a copy of the scores. The ESD does NOT want forms for athletics either. **The schools require testing every year that a student wants to participate in sports or other school activities.** If you have a problem or need a different form, call Nancy at (541-601-2257).

GENERAL INFORMATION

If your child will be 7 years old on this coming September 1st, he/she is NOT REQUIRED TO BE TESTED. You do need to register each child the FIRST year that you home school them (when they turn 7 by or on September 1st). Do not re-register in subsequent years. The phone number for the Jackson ESD is 541-776-8590, if you have questions for them.

Grades 3, 5, 8, and 10 are required to be tested by August 15th. We strongly recommend that you still begin testing your child as a 1st grader. Third grade is late to discover that you have a problem that testing might have alerted you to.

We will have a childcare area for those who want to volunteer, but have children who are not testing.

The entrance to where we will be testing at Bethel is on the lower parking lot. We will be registering near the front door. Vista Point Dr. is off of the new E. McAndrews Rd. extension before you get to Hillcrest Rd. Take Foothills Rd. to E. McAndrews. Watch for Vista Point Dr. and the big building which is Bethel Church on the left.

Please remember we need to be considerate of those testing. This year, everything will be inside of the main building, so it is VERY IMPORTANT that we be as quiet as possible. Depending on weather, we will have a spot where parents can wait during testing. We will know then if it's inside or out, or both.

Please do not smoke on church grounds.

Students need to get plenty of rest the night before testing. They will be more alert and able to concentrate better if their snack and drink is not sugary or simple carbohydrate.

SMALL GROUP TESTING

Think about how your child did last year and whether or not a large group will distract or hinder your child from showing what he/she really knows. If you decide that large group testing is not for one or more of your children, small group testers this year are: Nancy Olson (541-601-2257), Cindy Dick (541-772-4012), and Cecile Enright (541-821-6035). The cost for small group testing is \$45.00 per child and there are about 6 children testing at a time.

PLEASE NOTE: Testing days are MONDAY AND TUESDAY

This year testing is scheduled for **May 24-25** at **Bethel Church, 4245 Vista Point Dr., Medford**. **PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE CHURCH FOR TESTING INFORMATION.** All grades will test both Monday and Tuesday morning. Exact times will vary, depending on the grade. The **deadline for registering is April 30, 2010**. Registrations (you do **NOT** have to send payment with your registration) received after that date will have a \$5 per family late fee.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE CHANGE IN FEE STRUCTURE: If your family subscribes to the JCHE Newsletter the cost for testing is: \$30 for the first child, \$26 for the second child, and \$19 for each subsequent child. If you are NOT a newsletter subscriber, add \$5 for each child. There are opportunities to offset fees (\$5 per family per day) by volunteering on testing days. The \$5 credit is not automatic. Please check that you **DO** want work credit at the bottom of this form. You will **not have a late fee if your registration application (not including payment) is received by April 30. Payment may accompany application or be made the first morning of testing.**
